The AU-IIS is augmented with CNC turning machine, CNC Milling machine, Welding simulator, TIG/MIG Welding machines, AG-4, AG-7 grinding machines, Electrical Working board and healthcare equipments for providing training in the above said programmes.

12. In particular, we have a specialized Mechatronics Training Centre with latest equipments such as, PLC kit, Scada PLC kit, HMI & Sensor training kit, Pneumatic with PLC and Hydraulic with PLC. We have trained 24 final year students of Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering Technology, Karaikudi in Mechatronics. We also give training to the newly recruited faculty of ACCET in Welding, CNC and Mechatronics. As a result of our quality of training and latest amenities, the Alagappa Chettiar College of Engineering Technology, Karaikudi expresses its interest to sign MoU for extending the training to all its Students and Faculty.
