ALAGAPPA UNIVERSITY

Alagappa University, established by the Government of Tamil Nadu under an Act of the State Legislature in 1985, and located on a sprawling expanse of about 420 acres in the business town of Karaikudi in Sivagangai District in Tamil Nadu is ideally suited for higher education. The campus is accessible from Tiruchirappalli airport in about one and half hours and Madurai in about two hours by surface mode of transport.

This seat of Higher Education has emerged from the galaxy of institutions initially founded at Karaikudi during 1950's by the munificent and multifaceted personality, **Padma Bhushan Dr.RM.Alagappa Chettiar** and is groomed to prominence as yet another academic constellation in Tamil Nadu. As a member of the Commonwealth Universities and Association of Indian Universities, it has rewarding relations with other national and international **academic/ research/ industrial institutions** that promise a spectacular future to the learners.

The University's motto is "Excellence in Action" and it is determined to keep before it the vision of excellence in all spheres of education. To achieve this, it is continually upgrading its programs of studies and research and is a fore-runner in introducing many frontier level programs of learning as well.

It has been recognised under Sec.2(f) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. The University has been awarded with A+ Grade by NAAC (CGPA:3.64 out of 4) in the Third Cycle of assessment and also the first State University that obtained the A+ status in the State of Tamil Nadu. The University has been classified under Category-I status on account of its NAAC score. Alagappa University is placed 30th Ranking in University Category, 56th Ranking in Overall Category, 43rd Ranking in Research Institutions Category under National Institutional Ranking Frame work (NIRF) 2023 declared by the Ministry of Education (MoE), NewDelhi. Under OS World Ranking 2023, Alagappa University is placed 51st position in OS Southern Asia Ranking and the bandwidth of 251-260 in OS Asia University Ranking. Times Higher Education ranking (THE), Alagappa University has secured 122nd position in THE – ASIA (2022) ranking and 138th Position in the World Young University Ranking. Further, Alagappa University has shown remarkable improvement in Times Higher Education (THE) -World University ranking position from the bandwidth of 501-600 in 2022 to 401 - 500 bandwidth in 2023. Recognizing the extension activities, Mahatma Gandhi National council for Rural Education (MGNCRE), New Delhi, awarded the Alagappa University as "One District One Green Champion" and a Mentor Institution for Mainstreaming Swachhta Action Plan and Jal Shakthi Abhyan in rural areas through community engagements.

The University has five UGC-SAP (Special Assistance Programme) and six DST-FIST (Fund for improvement of Science and Technology) supported Departments. During the past five years, the University generated more than Rs. 20 crores from DST-PURSE, DST-FIST, UGC-SAP and DBT-BIC. Rs.20 crores from MoE, RUSA Phase 1.0 grant for creation and upgradation of infrastructure facilities and Rs.100 crores for improvement of Teaching, Learning and Research facilities under RUSA Phase 2.0 scheme. 49 International MoUs and 25 National MoUs were signed with international Universities and Institutes for Academic, Research, Industrial, faculty and students programmes. The University has made a milestone through 10270 publications with h-index 102 and the faculty members have filed 55 patents from their research work. The University has implemented digitalization through Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) facilities in the Central Library and Automation of Examination process. Alagappa University is adopting the Cashless transaction and Paperless communication in all administrative and academic endeavors apart from creating awareness to the public about Digital India. The University has established Community Radio (90.8 MHz) for community development.
