

## NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY - 2019

In honour of the great Indian Mathematician Shri Srinivasa Ramanujan's 132nd Birthday(22.12.2019), celebrated as National Mathematics Day on 17th December 2019, which was jointly organized by Department of Mathematics, and Ramanujan Centre for Higher Mathematics at Alagappa University. Hony. Col. Prof. N.
