From the Vice-Chancellor

Dear Readers,

I 14TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF VALLAL ALAGAPPAR CELEBRATED



The 114th Birth Anniversary of VallalAlagappar who paved the way for the founding of Alagappa University was celebrated in a grand manner on 6.4.2023. The grand event started in the early morning with a rally taken out from Bhavanagar Stadium (a favorite haunt of Dr.Alagappar) to VallalAlagappar Memorial Temple. The rally, led by Prof. G. Ravi, Vice-Chancellor, included the Syndicate Members, Faculty Members, Officials of the University, Non-teaching Staff and Students. They paid floral tributes at the Memorial Temple.

As a sequel later in the forenoon, a meeting was arranged at L.C.T.L. Palaniappa Chettiar Auditorium. Presiding over the meeting Prof. G. Ravi, Vice-Chancellor, said without the benefaction of Alagappar there would not have been an educational town called Karaikudi. It is noteworthy that Alagappar chose Karaikudi which was an educationally backward region then. The Vice-Chancellor concluded his speech by stating that the benefactor's blessing is one of the main reasons why Alagappa University stands out globally. By way of showing gratitude to the Founder, he said that the faculty should endeavour to excel both in teaching and research and prove their multi-dimensional approach. The administrative staff should handle the files promptly without delay and the students should realize their responsibilities and study well.

Sacrifices of Freedom Fighters Recalled

77th INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS

The Grand 77th Independence Day Celebrations at Alagappa University began with the hoisting of the Tricolour National Flag by Vice-Chancellor Prof. G. Ravi. He accepted the Guard of Honour presented by the NCC Cadets of the University.



In his Independence Day Address Vice-Chancellor stated: "The enormous freedom and democratic rights we enjoy in India are owing to the untold sufferings undergone by the freedom fighters. The Independence Day celebrations make all of us remember and recall the supreme sacrifices made by the patriots who were supported by millions and millions of ordinary people of India. In grateful remembrance of their sacrifices, let us salute the brave hearts and take a vow to strengthen the roots of freedom and nurture the growth of democracy. Recalling the core of the address delivered by Hon'ble

Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi, in his earlier Independence Day address, the Vice-Chancellor said that the Indian society has become an "aspirational society". Every citizen wants "speedy progress" in every sector in India. This is happening in the country. India is poised for remarkable growth. The young Indian population has a bright future. Skilled population is the need of the hour. Now, it is for young men and women to take advantage of the situation so as to develop themselves and the nation. The educational planners and institutions in India being aware of this are endeavouring to impart skill education, bring innovation and develop entrepreneurship. Alagappa University with its commitments to modern and progressive approach is endeavouring to contribute intensely to these training programmes.

The Hon'ble Minister of State for Education and External Affairs Dr. Rajkumar Ranjan Singh released the India Rankings 2023 for higher educational institutions in a function organized by the Ministry of Education (MoE) at New Delhi on 5.6.2023.A total of 8686 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) participated in the ranking exercise for various categories and subject domains. Among these, 2478 higher educational institutions participated in the Overall Category.

Alagappa University has secured the 30th position among the "Universities Category", 43rd position among the Research Institutions and 56th position under the "Overall Category" among the 2478 higher educational institutions assessed at the national level for the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF).

Among the StateUniversities that participated from Tamil Nadu,Alagappa University has secured the 3rd place in "Overall Institutions Category", "University Category" and "Research Institutions Category"

ALAGAPPA UNIVERSITY GETS IIITH RANK IN TIMES HIGHER EDUCATION ASIA RANKINGS

Alagappa Universityis placed in the 111th Rank in Times Higher Education ASIA Rankings - 2023 released by the Times Higher Education (THE) on 22.06.2023. A total of

928 institutions from Asia have secured different positions in Times Higher Education ASIA Universities Rankings - 2023. Alagappa University has secured the sixth place in the overall institutions ranked from India and the first place at the Tamil Nadu State level.

Under this THE World Ranking, the performance of the participating institutions under five specific areas, viz. Teaching, Research, Citations, International Outlook and Industry Income, have been assessed and analyzed. However, the weightings are recalibrated to reflect the attributes of Asia's Institutions. "13 carefully calibrated performance indicators are used for providing the most comprehensive and balanced comparisons, trusted by students, academics, university leaders, industry and governments", stated the release.

Sr. Prof. J. Jeyakanthan, Director, Alagappa University Ranking Cell and his team members collected, analyzed and submitted the data to participate in THE World Ranking pertaining to the year 2022.

Alagappa University is placed in the 101-150th ranking bandwidth in the "Young Universities Category" in Times Higher Education (THE) World Rankings 2023announced on 3rd July 2023. Higher Education Institutions founded between 1972 and the present were assessed for ranking in the Young Universities Category.

Alagappa University has secured the first place in Tamil Nadu in this Category and the 4th place in overall institutions ranked from India.

Under this THE world ranking, the performance of the participating institutions under five specific areas, viz. Teaching, Research, Knowledge Transfer, International Outlook and Industry Income, have been assessed and analyzed. However, the weightings are recalibrated to reflect the profile of missions of young universities. The 13 parameters are calibrated to reflect the profile of missions of Young Universities.

Prof. J. Jeyakanthan, Director, Alagappa University Ranking Cell, collected, analyzed and submitted the data to participate in THE World Ranking pertaining to the year 2022.

This THE world Rankings 2023- Young Universities Category is an additional diamond added to the crown of Alagappa University.

Alagappa University has been placed in the ranking bandwidth of 601-800 in Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2024. It was announced by THE on 27th September 2023. The release said 10,050 institutions from across 108 countries participated and 2673 institutions submitted data to THE ranking. Overall, 1904 Universities have been ranked. Alagappa University has secured the second postion among the universities from Tamil Nadu and secured the sixth place in overall University Ranking in India.

Under this THE world ranking, the performance of the participating institutions are assessed under four specific areas, viz. Teaching, Research, Knowledge Transfer and International Outlook. THE ranking has analyzed more than 134 million citations across more than 16.5 million research publications. It included survey responses from 68402 scholars globally.

Prof. J. Jeyakanthan, Director, Alagappa University Ranking Cell, analyzed and submitted the data received from various Faculties of Alagappa University for the participation in THE World University Ranking pertaining to the year 2023.

WEEK- LONG ANTI-RAGGING PROGRAMME CONDUCTED



A week-long Programme on Anti-Ragging was inaugurated at Alagappa University, Karaikudi on 14.08.2023 and it continued upto 18.08.2023.

Presiding over the inaugural event, Vice-Chancellor Prof. G. Ravi said that Alagappa University has a peaceful and disciplined atmosphere where no ragging incidents take place. A law to prevent ragging was first enacted in Tamil Nadu in 1997, followed by Maharashtra in 1999. Ragging, he said, involves humiliating and harassing freshers either physically or mentally by senior students in educational institutions. He said the University Grants Commission introduced a toll-free anti-ragging helpline in 2009 to prevent this offence in higher education institutions. He said that although there is no ragging in Alagappa University, the students who study here should create an awareness about the cruelty of ragging among the students who study in other educational institutions.

Prof. S. Rajaram, Member of the Syndicate, in his welcome address, said that every year on 12th August the anti-ragging day is observed in higher educational institutions to create awareness among the students about the prevention of ragging incidents. The University Grants Commission has instructed to hold this event as a week-long programme in the universities. He also said that this event is being held to create awareness that no threat should be made to the students studying in educational institutions on the basis of religion, caste, gender or economic conditions.

All Women Police Station Inspector Mrs. V. Satyaseela of Karaikudi Station delivered the keynote address on the occasion. In her speech she gave an explanation of the laws enacted by the governments to prevent it. Students should engage themselves in activities that benefit others. No one should be harassed physically or mentally. She also explained the punishments to be meted out on those involved in ragging incidents. She asked the students to follow the rules of the road -- to wear helmets, to avoid travelling of three persons in a two-wheeler, and to avoid driving under the influence of alcohol.

Earlier, Alagappa University Registrar i/c, Prof. S. Rajamohan welcomed the gathering. Dean, Student Affairs Prof. C. Vethirajan proposed a vote of thanks. More than 400 students belonging to the Management Departments of the University participated in the event.

Seminar on Mahakavi Bharathiar and National Freedom Movement

The Department of English and Foreign Languages in collaboration with the Department of Tamil organized a "Seminar on Mahakavi Bharathiar and National Freedom Movement" on Tuesday the 14th August 2023. The objectives of the seminar are to remember with gratitude the contributions of Mahakavi Bharathiar to the cause of India's Freedom, to revisit his patriotism filled literary creations and to make known to the present generation of students his services to empowerment of women, abolition of social and economic inequalities and his endeavors at the propagation of Indian culture, spiritual beliefs and Indian way of life.



Presiding over the seminar, Prof. G. Ravi Vice-Chancellor stated that Mahakavi Bharathiar stood for national consciousness, traditional Indian ethos and its transfer to successive generations. Through his mighty poetic compositions, the Vice-Chancellor said, Bharathiar woke up the common men and women and inspired nationalist and patriotic feelings in them. He expressed his great admiration for Bharathiar who, he said, was not at all scared of the oppressive measures of the British Indian Government. The Vice-Chancellor exhorted the students to read the immortal poetry of Mahakavi Bharathiar to imbibe profound thoughts found in it and also to acquire competence through hard work to create literary works like Mahakavi Bharathiar.

After that Prof. NP. Manickam, Former Professor of English from Alagappa Government Arts College dwelt at length on the thoughts, words and deeds of Mahakavi Bharathiar which he said revolved only around the liberty of India. He explained to students in his keynote address that Bharathiar used to be a polyglot who is said to have known many languages and who established the eminence of Tamil Language. The keynote speaker illustrated that Mahakavi Bharathiar's love for India was boundless. He sang about Himalayas, the perennial rivers of India and the nation's spiritual beliefs and practices. Prof. NP. Manickkam further spoke about Mahakavi Bharathiar's creating of greater awakening of people about India's independence through his fiery articles in journals he worked with. He further elaborated on Mahakavi Bharathiar's entry into the landscape of media his employments with the renowned journals like Sudheshamitaran, India Bala Bharatham, Karmayoki and Suryodhayam wherein his inspiring articles were published. He criticized vehemently the British Indian Government's religion-based partition of Bengal. The Senior Professor articulated: that the inflammatory speeches of Mahakavi Bharathiar angered the British Indian Government so much that it issued arrest warrant against him. He was to depart to French-held Pondicherry and lived underground for many years. His great works Panjali

Sabatham, Kannan Pattu and Kuyil Pattu both delighted and instructed the masses. His demise took place in 1921.

After that Dr. Kannathal, Former Professor of Tamil from Alagappa Government Arts College focused on Mahakavi's contribution to gender emancipation of women. She said Bharathiar believed gender freedom is as important as political freedom. Her discourse highlighted Bharathiar's struggle for women's education through which he believed India's independence can be attained. Prof. Kannathal explicated that Mahakavi Bharathiar dreamt that women should pursue higher education and adorn greater positions breaking the barriers of slavery.

Earlier Prof. P. Madhan, Head of the Department of English and Foreign Languages, welcomed the gathering and delivered the introductory speech by focusing on the birth, upbringing, education and series of employments of Mahakavi Bharathiar. He said that the significant seminar was organized as per the instructions of the Hon'ble Governor of Tamil Nadu Thiru. R.N. Ravi.

defence in global arena. Prof. S. Thanuskodi, Dean, Faculty of Arts, welcomed the participants and highlighted the significance of the programme.

Prof. K. Senthilkumar presented the thematic introduction of the webinar. He explained about the proliferation of nuclear weapons; and he said how their delivery is a threat to international and regional peace and stability. The fight against proliferation is thus a priority for all the nations of the world, he added.

In her special address, Dr. M. Narmada, Head, Department of Defence Studies, Pollachi College of Arts & Science, Pollachi, said that nuclear weapons remain central to international politics. She elaborated that proliferation has been opposed by many nations with and without nuclear weapons, as governments fear that more countries with nuclear weapons will increase the possibility of nuclear warfare, de-stabilization of international relations and threatening of the global security. She added that India has been an ardent advocate of arms control and disarmament. India was the first country to propose a nuclear test ban treaty and a cut-off on the production of materials meant for producing nuclear weapons.

Further, Dr. M. Narmada said that India's nuclear triad consists of air launched nuclear weapons and sea launched ballistic missiles, as well as land-based ballistic missiles. The Federation of American Scientists has estimated that India has approximately 156 nuclear warheads. Therefore, the exact number of nuclear weapons that India possesses is not clear, but it is believed to be in the range of 140 to 156 warheads.

Finally, Dr. N.K. Bhuvaneswari, Teaching Assistant, Department of Politics and Public Administration, proposed a vote of thanks.

Two-Day International Symposium on Bioplastics Organised

A Two-Day SPARC-Sponsored "International Symposium on Bioplastics" (ISB -23) was organized by the Department of Microbiology in collaboration with Office of Industry and Consultancy & University Business Collaboration Centre (UBCC), Alagappa University, Karaikudi, on 12th& 13th September, 2023 at the Seminar Hall of the Science Campus of the University.



Presiding over the event Prof. G. Ravi, Vice-Chancellor, Alagappa University, said that one of the biggest environmental problems facing the modern society is the pollution of the environment caused by plastic waste. Plastic pollution is emerging as a great threat to many ecosystems, including coral reefs. Another major problem is the formation of microplastics by the breakdown of large pieces of plastic for over several years and these micro plastics have now invaded our food products and affect the health of human beings. For a circular economy, it is critical to find environmentally benign bioplastics with qualities comparable to conventional polymers and sustainable recycling possibilities. He added that all research should eventually benefit people and the industry. He urged scholars across all disciplines to place more value on highquality research than on the volume of publications. He stated that there is no safe planet except earth to live in

comfortably. So we have to protect our planet without plastic pollution. Hydrogen is the alternative energy source for petroleum. Alagappa University has been jointly working with GRT industry from 2016 onwards for the synthesis of hallow fibre membrane for water purification. The company is giving training to our students. Madras IIT research park is working as a model for other institutions to commercialize their findings. In near future our University is going to work in collaboration with H2 Next Company for the production of hydrogen from the waste. He added that institutions and industries have to collaborate and travel together in the same direction for the betterment of our country.

Hazardous Impact of Micro Plastics

Prof. K. Murugan, Former Vice-Chancellor of Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore, presently CSIR-Emeritus Professor at Bharathiyar University, in his inaugural address, said that proper disposal of the plastic waste will save our planet; and he added instead of using petroleum byproducts we can use biopolymers like chitosan based polymers to manufacture the plastics, which is derived from microorganisms and plants as well as biodegradable.

Prof. M. Govarthanan from Kyungpook National University, South Korea, in his felicitation, referred to the hazardous impact of micro plastics on aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems. In order to avoid such problems plant biomass can be used as an alternative source for the synthesis of biopolymers, by which soil and water ecosystem can be protected.

Mr. G. Simiyon, Assistant Director, Head of Office of MSME, while offering felicitation at the function exhorted the scholars to concentrate on researches that address the public issues. He exhorted them to commercialize the products by getting financial support from the government and added that funds are given to motivate the budding researchers and loans are given for the entrepreneurs.

196 participants from various universities and institutions from across the country, and a small number of representatives from industries attended the event.

Members of the Syndicate, Faculty Members, Research Scholars and Students from various Departments of Alagappa University were present on the occasion. Prof. A.
